COVID-19 VACCINE Timeline

2020

DECEMBER

BETWEEN NOW AND THE END OF THE YEAR:

- Arbor communities receive distribution plans at the statewide level.
- Walgreens schedules vaccination clinic dates for the Arbor communities.
- Arbor communities receive vaccination consent forms.
- The process begins to schedule the first vaccination clinic to administer first dose to residents and staff.

2021

JANUARY

BEGINNING EARLY 2021:

- First vaccination clinic held to administer first dose to residents and staff in communities that did not have a scheduled clinic in 2020
- Second clinic held for: 2nd dose for those who have received the 1st dose, 1st dose for unvaccinated residents and staff.
- Third clinic to administer 2nd dose as needed to residents and staff.

2021

SPRING/SUMMER

LATER IN 2021:

• The vaccine should be available to the general public later in 2021.

ADDITIONAL DETAILS:

- The vaccine distribution process is subject to availability and controlled by the state government. Information is constantly changing, and we will attempt to provide the most current and up-to-date information as soon as it becomes available.
- This timeline is based on information as of 12/10/20. These details may change as new information becomes available.
- In order to receive the vaccine at one of our Arbor Company community clinics, residents must have financial possession and be present at the scheduled time of the vaccine. Vaccines will only be distributed during these pre-scheduled clinics.
